

Papagayo Beach Resort



Papagayo Beach Resort is situated on Jan Thiel Bay, 12 miles from the airport, 3 miles from Willemstad and just 100 metres from the ocean. The SeaQuarium and Mambo Beach are 3 miles away. Papagayo

has won awards for their strong conservation policy. Papagayo tries to minimise its impact on the environment by saving energy and water and by reprocessing waste and waste water. This luxurious resort is 75 spaciouly laid out villas, built in colonial style and furnished by Jan des Bouvrie, a famous Dutch architect. The villas are surrounded by a lush tropical garden with exotic flowers and Caribbean plants such as Aloe Vera and Caribbean palm trees, home to brightly coloured exotic birds. In these serene surroundings, you can completely unwind.

Accommodation

Each colonial-style villa is the same layout. Natural materials used in the villa create a comfortable tropical atmosphere

A very large living room, the two outside walls are louvered wooden panels, folding back to open two complete walls onto a terrace on both sides of the villa. The terrace has screens from the roof to the terrace, and this makes a very large, shaded living area, giving a superb sense of natural space. Television, direct dial telephone, safe, open kitchen, with fridge, dishwasher, coffeemaker and microwave/grill oven, two bedrooms - air-conditioned, two en suite bathrooms - shower, wash basin and toilet, ceiling fan.

The Resort offers:

Internet, dry cleaning and laundry service, housekeeping three times a week, beach towels are free, welcome grocery packages (on request -small charge), babysitting service (charge), children's activities, games on Jan Thiel Beach, snorkeling under supervision, soccer, volleyball, Seasons Restaurant - open daily for all meals, large swimming pool, children's pool, pool deck with comfortable lounge beds.

A large reef, inhabited by lots of marine life, protects the bay from ocean waves. Scuba Do is a 5 * PADI dive centre, on the beach, the associated dive school for the above resorts. They offer all levels of instruction and a range of boat diving excursions, to the nearby reefs. Scuba Do have a wide range of equipment for sale or hire. Also on Jan Thiel beach is a small water playground for children, sun beds (small charge), beach volleyball and pedal boats for hire.
